It is vital that your child attends school regularly and on time.

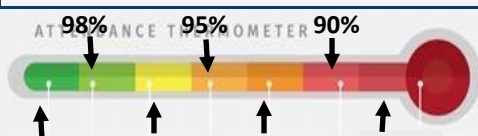
Any absences must be reported to school via email, phone or the Parent Hub app by 9.00am.
