- Talk about what they have done and say, with help, what they think they have found out.

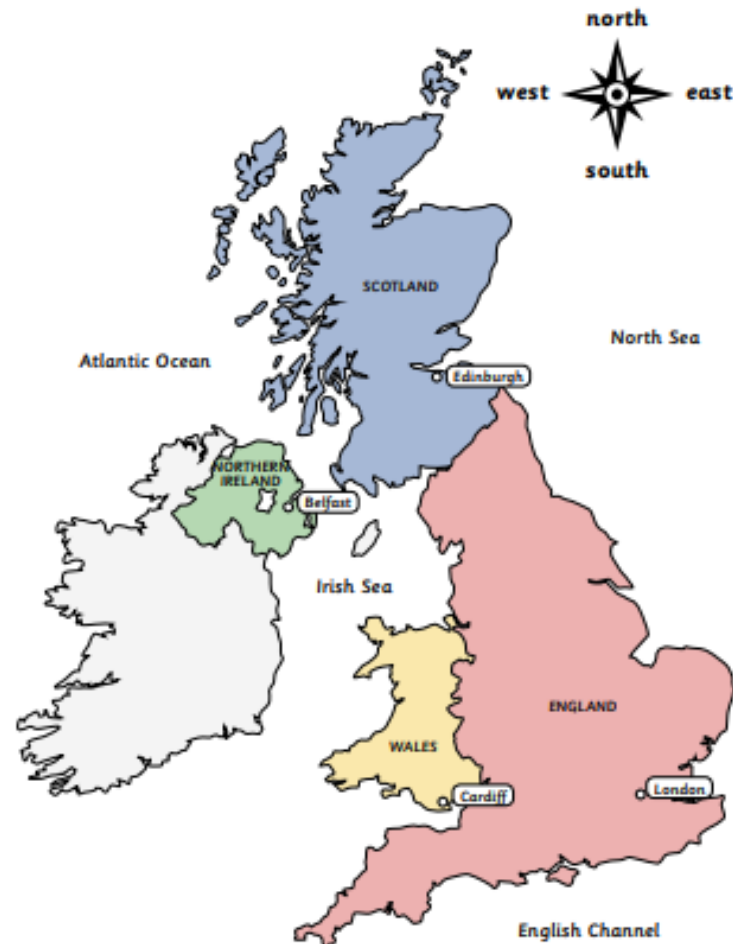
By the end of the topic we will be able to...
