While Year Four jetted off to South America to the Amazon Rainforest and the Galapagos Islands.

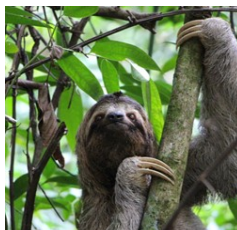
The children said...

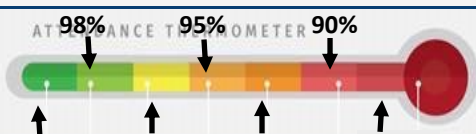

Year One

This week has been STEM week at Lakeside. Across the school children have been working on activities promoting science, technology, engineering and maths.

In Year 1 the children have enjoyed taking part in many STEM activities. They have made nests, created rainbow milk art and even made some rocket mice.

We have had so much fun investigating and understanding 'how it works'.

STEM Week

STEM in Lakeside typically focus on project-based learning. The children get to apply the various domains of STEM in a context that helps them realize a connection between the classroom and the world around them. STEM encompasses Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths.

For the last two years the children have taken part in half-termly STEM activities that allow them to use a cross-curricular approach to solve problems. For example transporting tomatoes in Nepal down a mountain so they can be sold in the market.

This week the children have all taken part in a Rocket Mice experiment where they had to see who could get their rocket to travel the furthest distance. They were able to modify their Rocket Mice and retest to find the best solution. The children had great fun and I'm sure they will tell all you all about it.

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
