

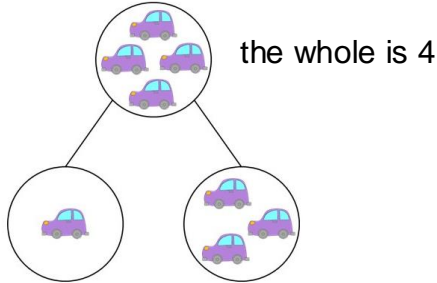


Early Years Newsletter 15th November 2024

In Early Years this week we have continued to learn about Festivals and Celebrations starting off with Remembrance day on Monday. We learnt why the poppy helps us remember the soldiers and animals from the wars. Diwali is an important festival for Hindus and we listened to the story of Rama and Sita and learnt about the ways we celebrate with food, music and dance. In the creative area we made Diya lamps as well as lanterns to celebrate the festival of light. In the Forest we re-told the story and created different pathways with lights. In Maths last week we learnt about part, part whole models and this week we have been practising what we have learnt sorting objects into two groups and identifying the parts and the whole.

CHRISTMAS CRAFTS

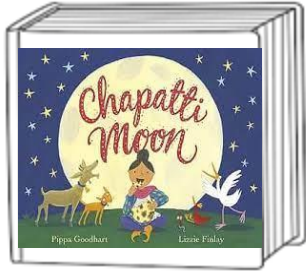


17th December 1:30pm

- Find objects in your home to sort into groups and practise your part whole storytelling



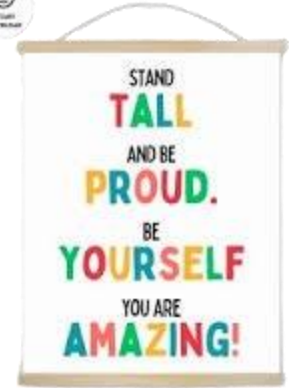
