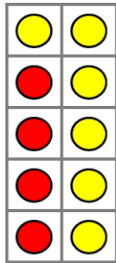

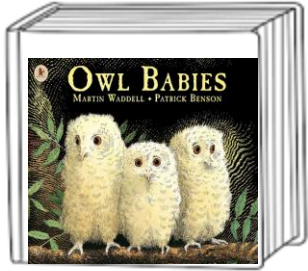
Counting to 9 and 10

Some activities you could try at home with your child this week:

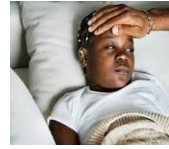
- Find 3 objects and order them from longest to shortest.
