CORONAVIRUS UPDATE – SCHOOL WILL REMAIN OPEN

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the government announcement this afternoon, the **school will be remaining open** for the foreseeable future. At this time, we have not been informed of any reason why we should need to close the school. There are currently no confirmed cases of Coronavirus from any pupils or staff at Lakeside Primary Academy.

If a pupil begins to develop the symptoms of Coronavirus (a new continuous cough, high temperature, shortness of breath), parents should contact NHS 111 to seek medical advice and inform the school.

In the event of a confirmed case, the NHS and Public Health England will advise parents and the school on the course of action to take. The academy is reviewing the government's guidance daily, and will take all necessary action to protect the students and staff by taking advice from Public Health England, the NHS and the Department for Education.
